The Air Resources Board has a regulation to reduce emissions from existing off-road vehicles with large spark-ignition (LSI) engines used in California. These vehicles are found in public and private industries as diverse as manufacturing, wholesale & retail goods movement, utilities, and construction. The In-Use Off-Road Large Spark-Ignition Engine Fleet Regulation (LSI Fleet Regulation) requires fleet operators to conduct a baseline inventory of their fleet and then achieve fleet average emission standards. Recently, ARB adopted amendments to the LSI Fleet Regulation that clarified requirements for fleets involved in agricultural, forest, and equipment dealer operations; reinstated limited hours of use provisions; and broadened compliance extension provisions. Owners of off-road vehicles with LSI engines (mentioned above) are strongly encouraged to attend this training.

This course will cover:

- The applicability of the LSI Fleet Regulation;
- Current and future fleet average requirements;
- Recordkeeping requirements;
- Compliance extension provisions.
